

Finally an alternative supply for check-out stands manufacturers: SIREM launches its new drum motor RL113

SIREM, one of the major players in the industry of motorized drums, has designed a new 113mm diameter drum motor for belt conveyors of checkout stands which enhances its existing range of RL80 and RL72.



"The availability in Europe of a reliable and **non-proprietary alternative** for the motorization of check-out conveyors is a cash contribution of SIREM to the highly competitive market of check-out stands," said Bernard Guionie, Sales Product Manager of SIREM for check-out market.

This new drum motor has been specifically designed to offer all the assets expected by check-out stands manufacturers: robustness, reliability, silence of use, easy installation and maintenance-free operation. Sirem also paid a particular attention to the inertia of the roller thus ensuring smooth starts and stops.

In series, these drum motors are equipped with a standard connector MOLEX which leaves the freedom to manufacturers to make himself or to procure from SIREM or any sub-contractor of his choice, his custom cable.

In an ongoing effort to sustainable development and reducing operating costs, power consumption has been reduced by 15%.

The RL113 range is now available with single-phase motors rating 0.11KW and 0.075KW and with a belt speed of 0.09m/s, 0.11m/s, 0.13m/s and 0.15m/s.

The 3-phase 50Hz and single-phase 60Hz versions will be available in April 2010.

As part of the launch of this new product and until June 30th, 2010, SIREM grants a special discount of 7% on first order.
